


Dear Friends and Family,

Our Christmas programs were very successful through all three of our churches. Bruno has been attending all seminary courses and preaching lessons and

will now be taking over as the pastor in training at the church. It has been an honor to work with Bruno and I am excited to see him in this next step in ministry. Please pray for him as he tries to help this church as they continue to suffer because of Antoine's passing. Pray that he will be able to be a godly pastor that can effectively show the grace and love of Jesus Christ for the church.



Prayer for Travel

Another prayer request I have is that I will be traveling most of January as I am taking more responsibility for Equipping Farmers International (E.F.I.). On January 9th I will be visiting Nigeria as we are looking to start a center for training farmers in Nigeria. They have already carried out three training courses for over 60 pastors in their area, and they have seen the pastors return to their churches and start practicing

conservation agriculture. Then I will head to Liberia, which is the first and biggest E. F. I. training center in West Africa. They have already successfully run several trainings and have even successfully grown upland rice with our conservation agriculture. We are planning to prepare this training center to become fully self-sustaining and be certified by the founding organization Foundation for Farming later this year. The day after I return, I will help in running a training as the local SIM church will be sending their pastors to be trained in conservation agriculture at our farm here in Burkina Faso

Please pray that the trips go will as it well be the first time I have traveled as the regional coordinator with E. F. I. But mostly pray for Bonnie and the kids as they will be staying here in Burkina Faso. The country has been stable recently, but there is always a worry that problems will start back up. Pray things stay stable during the travel.
